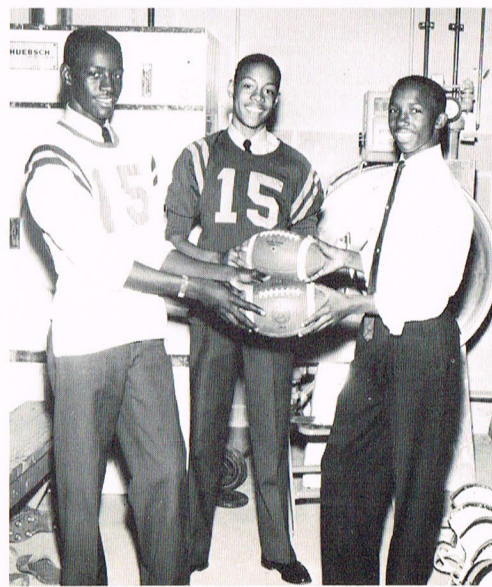


LINEMEN AND LINE COACH

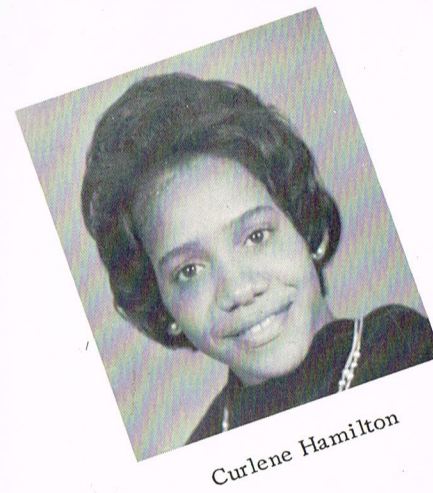
# ... NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY ...
