# FOREWORD

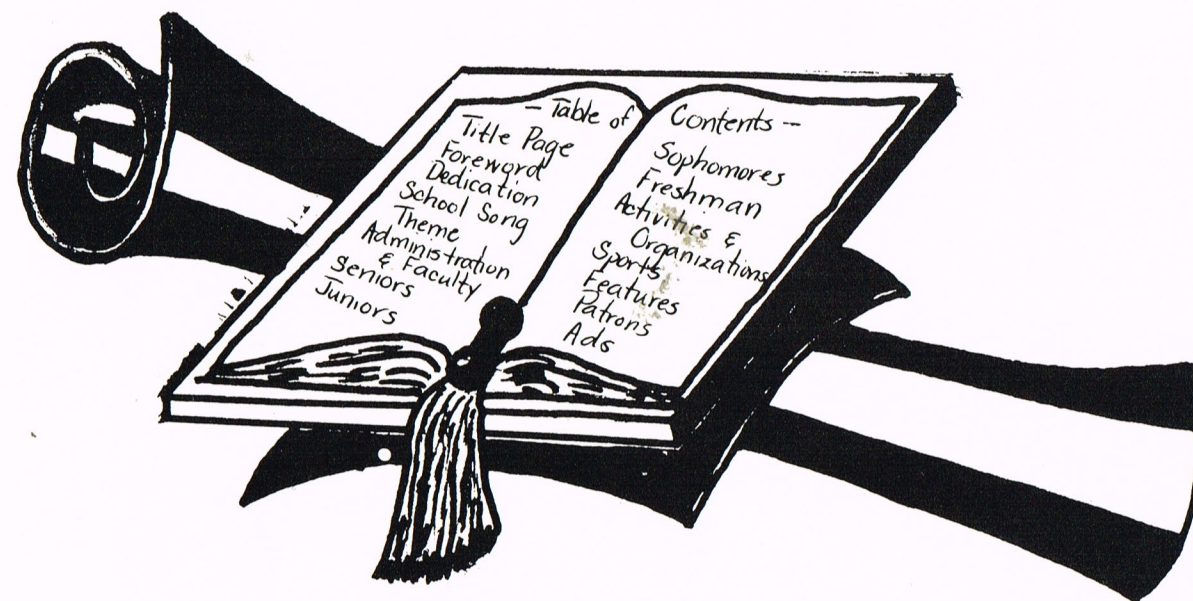
We, the members of the 1964 Graduating Class leave our school, which we love so dear, with memories retrospective of our experiences and accomplishments embodied in these sacred pages.
