SPORTS HISTORY

Football--The Golden Wildcats active season began with their annual Red and White scrimmage at the school stadium. It opened with a bang as the Reds, consisting of what was then the first team line and second team backs, struck first with an 80 yard scoring pass from then quarterback Larry Mallory to split end Ralph Wiley. The Whites came back on a dazzling 53 yard run by James Fitzpatrick, but the Reds prevailed when Nat Pigrum scored on a one yard plunge to the final score, 13 to 7. This explosive action was typical of the '69 Cats. With a dazzling array of backs including halfbacks James Ritzpatrick, Robert Aldridge and Ken Hill, Fullbacks James Parham and Nat Pigrim and quarterback Larry Perkins to carry the ground forces; a bevy of excellent wide receivers, including ends James Thompson, Ralph Wiley and Larry Mallory, for quick strikes through the air and the finest interior lineman in the city, some of which are Ed Murrell, Robert Brooks, Willie Pegues at guard, Al Robinson, Leno Perkins and Clarence Seiferth at tackles and center-captain Chris Jones, to grind massive holes in the line. With this line-up of exceptional talent and more the Cats swept through Washington 25--6, Howard 20--6, Carver 41--13, Hamilton 22--8, Central 38--13, Northside 55--0, Frayser 32--0, Treadwell 40--0, and a resounding 52--14 victory over Lester in the annual Blues Bowl game. The only imperfection in this season were a tough 6--0 loss to a hard-nosed, but extremely lucky C.B.H.S. team and a heart-breaking scoreless tie with powerful South Side. The Cats scored a whopping 325 points to their opponents 65. Against Northside they set a school record of 26 first downs, and at the end of the season Larry Perkins, Larry Mallory, Chris Jones and Willie Pegues made the All-Memphis team. To the Golden Wildcats of 70-71, we hope that they improve on our 9--1--1 record, and we leave you our legacy of carrying on the Melrose Tradition of winning.

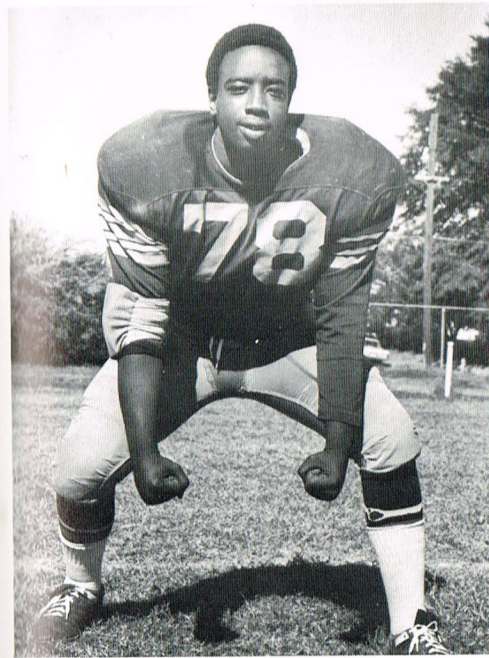
Basketball--The Cats who finished third in the state last year, had another powerhouse this year. Led by sharpshooters Willie Maris, Ed Benton, James Thompson, Glen Palmer, Ramon Watkins and Larry Mallory, defensive stalwarts, John Sanders, Clyde Munn, Melvin Caldwell, and Willie Walker, the Cats are favored to take their division easily and try the state again. After dropping two games because of illness, the Cats have blasted out four wins by substantial scores. They will go into the Knights of Columbus Tournament intact and again be the most formidable team in West Tennessee.

Baseball and Track--The baseball team returns 8 lettermen of the successful 869 team and have high hopes of clinching the National League title. Added hitting power will contribute to their drive. In track, always a Melrose specialty, the Wildcats will return almost all of their city runner-up team. Larry Perkins and David West, state participants last year, will again provide the inspiration for the cindermen.
